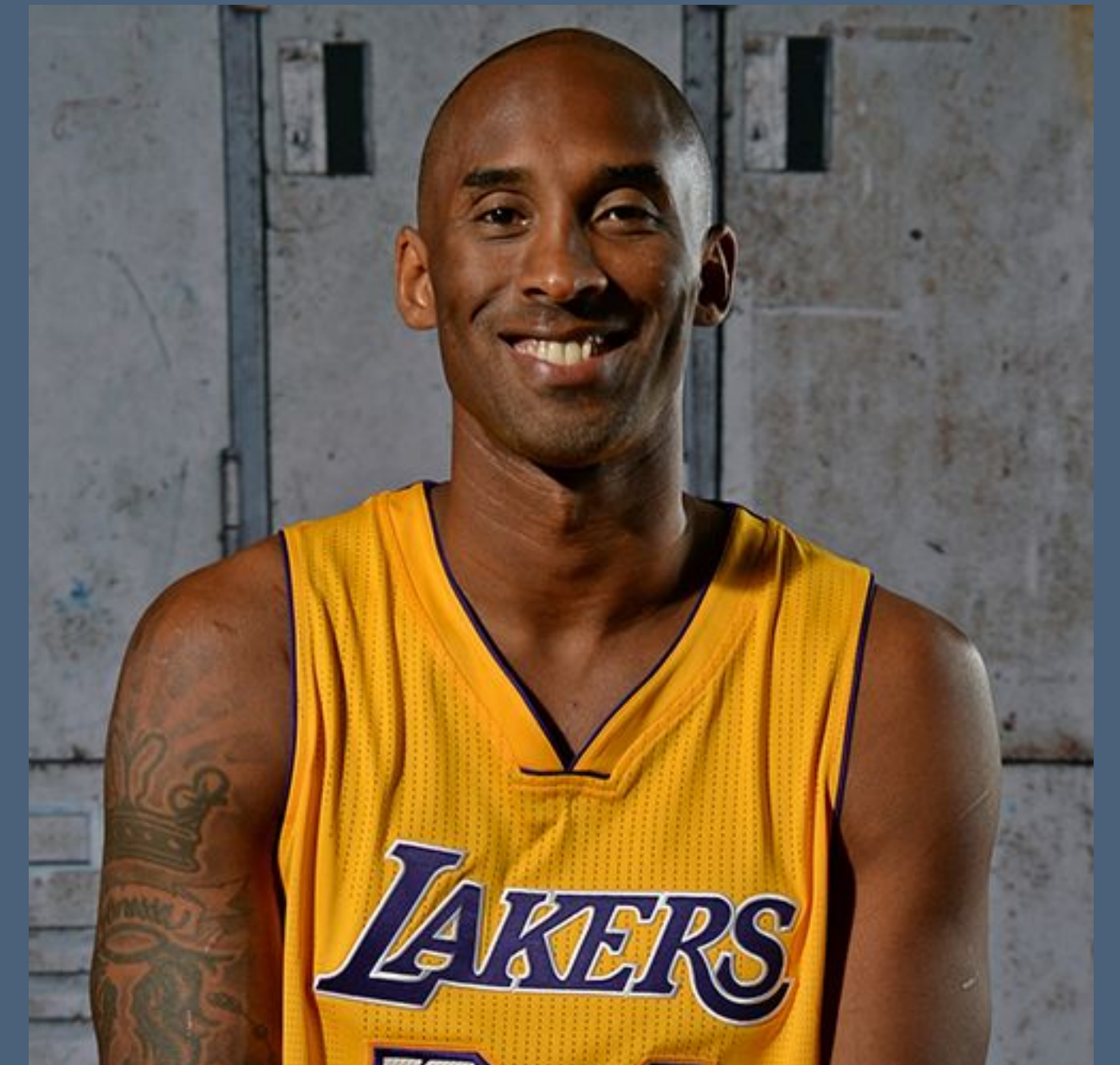
Success

Challenges

- Emphasize Scholarship
 - Average GPA has dropped
 - Spring '23 All Member Term GPA = 3.274 (IFC Average = 3.220)
 - Spring '24 All Member Term GPA = 3.183 (IFC Average = 3.276)
- Percent of member on Dean's List has declined
 - Spring '23 - 44.44%
 - Spring '24 - 33.33%
